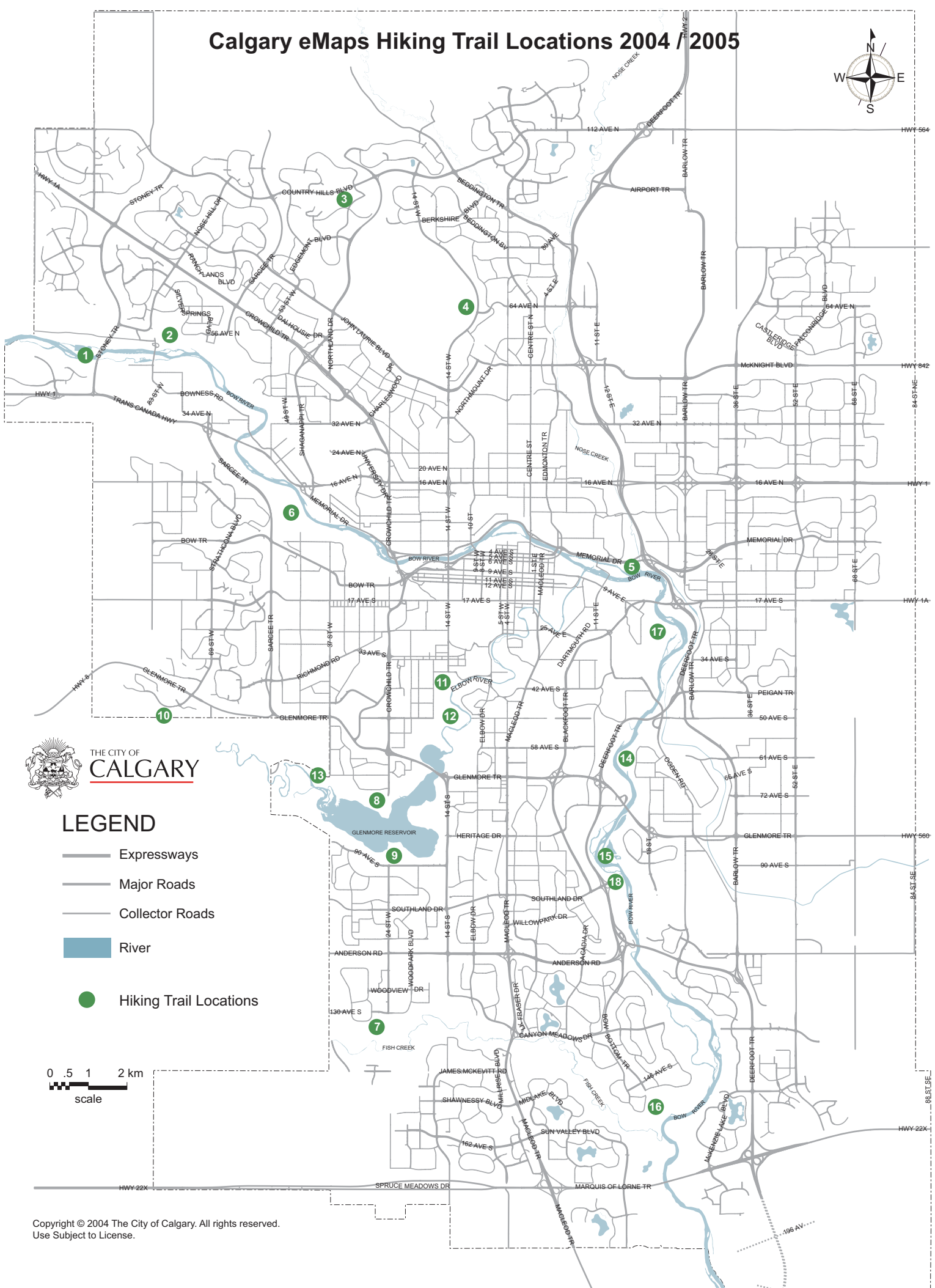







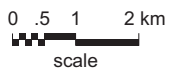
# Calgary eMaps Hiking Trail Locations 2004 / 2005
